





# HOW MANY VOLCANOES ARE IN ICELAND?

There are approximately 130 volcanoes in Iceland, active and inactive. About 30 active volcanic systems can be found under the island, in all parts of the country other than the Westfjords.



# SKEIÐARÁRJÖKULL

- > One of the most active volcanic areas
- Lake Grímsvötn
- Geothermal heat that melts ice

 $\succ$  The most active volcano

Last eruption 2011

> 700 meters of thick ice



# SKEIÐARÁRBRÚ

#### Longest bridge in Iceland

destroyed in a volcanic eruption

It was 904 meters is now 880 meters




To get to the waterfall you have to walk up a steep hill
